ABOUT JUSTDIGGIT

JustdiggIt empowers farmers and pastoralists in Sub-Saharan Africa to restore degraded landscapes using rainwater harvesting, agroforestry, and climate resilient agriculture. In the next 10 years it is our goal to restore millions of hectares of degraded land on the African continent by combining nature based solutions with data and modern technology. To support our efforts and increase impact, we have awareness campaigns running throughout Europe and Africa.



WHO WE ARE LOOKING FOR

We are looking for a talented program manager that brings our landscape restoration efforts in Senegal to the next level. An environmentalist with an entrepreneurial mindset and experience in program management, having the ambition to personally and professionally grow together with us. In this role, you will be Justdiggit's only representative in Senegal contributing to the growth of the program and our presence in Senegal and in West Africa.

Since 2023 we are active in Senegal, working together with three regreening partners - farmer associations - on a program that aims to regenerate millions of trees in the peanut basin. Over the past two years we have regenerated around 100,000 trees in 30 villages. For 2026 the main objective is to further develop program implementation with our partners and mobilise resources to secure expansion.



SCOPE OF WORK

- Provide program coordination and advisory support to Justdiggit's projects in Senegal, ensuring effective planning, implementation, monitoring, and impact.
- Contribute with technical expertise and guidance to our regreening partners, supporting the delivery against donor requirements and Justdiggit standards.
- Provide basic technical, monitoring & evaluation, and communications support to our regreening partners to strengthen project implementation and quality.
- Manage regreening partner contracting processes and maintain oversight of compliance with agreed scope, budget, and deliverables.
- Conduct field visits as necessary to project sites and partners to provide support, strengthen collaboration, and ensure effective implementations and agreed outputs.
- Deliver high-quality narrative and financial reports for funding partners in close coordination with relevant Justdiggit teams.
- Support business development by contributing to proposals and strategies that attract new funders and advance Justdiggit's growth in Senegal.
- Collaborate with the Justdiggit team and coordinate activities in line with agreed deliverables and maintain strong working relationships with regreening partners, government actors, and community stakeholders.
- Represent Justdiggit in Senegal by cultivating strategic partnerships with stakeholders, donors, and media, and driving a growth agenda aligned with organizational objectives.

- Hands-on approach, strong initiative, and a positive, solutions-oriented mindset.
- Strong organisational, administrative, analytical, and prioritisation skills, with the ability to work both independently and collaboratively.
- Several years of experience in a comparable role and a relevant professional network in the restoration or environmental sector.
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills.
- Fluent in English, French and Wolof, verbally and on paper.
