ABOUT JUSTDIGGIT

Justdiggit is an international non-profit organisation that restores degraded ecosystems in Africa by making drylands green again — with a positive impact on climate, ecosystems, and people.

We empower smallholder farmers in Sub-Saharan Africa to restore degraded landscapes using rainwater harvesting, agroforestry, and climate-resilient agriculture. We are currently active in Kenya, Tanzania, and Senegal, with offices in Arusha (Tanzania), Nairobi (Kenya), and Amsterdam (the Netherlands).



WHAT WILL YOU BE DOING AT JUSTDIGGIT?

For our colleagues, partners, and donors, we are creating a series of Impact Factsheets: web pages that clearly explain how we measure our impact, what results we achieve, which scientific evidence supports our work, and where knowledge gaps still exist.

We are looking for an intern to support the creation of these Impact Factsheets. In this role, you will:

- Learn from colleagues how Justdiggit measures impact across different themes (such as water, biodiversity, soil, and livelihoods) and write clear, accessible summaries of these methods and results.
- Search our internal servers and speak with colleagues to identify relevant past work (e.g. student reports, pilot projects, and research partnerships) and create structured overviews of what has already been done.
- Review scientific literature and summarise what research shows about how landscape restoration contributes to these impact areas.
- Work with our Business development and Communications teams to translate this into accurate and inspiring impact stories

WHAT ARE WE LOOKING FOR?

We are looking for someone who:

- Is a strong communicator, able to translate complex and technical information into language that is inspiring and easy to understand for a broad audience.
- Works thoroughly and carefully, as information can sometimes be difficult to find or interpret and accuracy is essential.
- Has the ability to distinguish scientific evidence from anecdotal evidence and the ability to formulate impact results from different sources in an accurate way, preventing inaccurate or unsubstantiated impact claims.
- Has a good understanding of landscape restoration interventions, and the theories and mechanisms behind the long term impacts of those interventions — for example, a student in earth sciences, international land & water management, ecology, environmental sciences, or a related field.

WHAT WE OFFER

- The opportunity to contribute to a meaningful mission: regreening our planet.
- Hands-on experience with translating impact measurement, monitoring, and scientific evidence into inspiring communication tools, in a real-world NGO context.
- Experience working in an international non-profit organisation with colleagues across Africa and Europe.
- An internship allowance and reimbursement of commuting costs.
- A hybrid working setup: at least one day per week at our Amsterdam office, and the option to work partly from home.
