Justdiggitt ([www.justdiggitt.org](http://www.justdiggitt.org)) is a non-profit organisation based in the Netherlands, working on landscape restoration in Africa. Justdiggitt restores degraded landscapes using rainwater harvesting, agroforestry, and climate resilient agriculture techniques. In Kenya, we work with a range of interventions to restore degraded rangelands using water harvesting and grazing management. In Tanzania, we inform and train farmers to bring back trees on their farms.

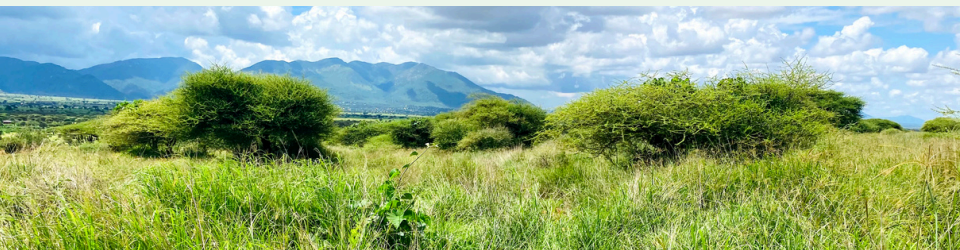
We have a hugely ambitious goal: we want to enable 350 million subsistence farmers in Sub-Saharan Africa to regreen their own land before 2030!

# ROLE & RESPONSIBILITIES

You will be part of the Justdiggit Business Development, Fundraising & Partnerships team. This team identifies strategy and funding opportunities through new and existing partnerships so that we can increase our (climate) impact and continue to grow in the coming years. We have ambitious goals and are looking for someone who wants to help grow this global regreening movement, so that we can cool down our planet!

Your role as a Business Development, Fundraising & Partnership intern is very diverse with a variety of tasks, that can be further specified in our interview. But to give you an idea:

- You support the team across a variety of tasks—conducting market and trend research, drafting proposals and propositions, identifying funding opportunities, updating our ‘impact pages’ (reports) with new data and helping engage partners. Your analytical mindset, results-oriented approach, and clear writing will make a real difference.
- You will be in contact with (international) foundations, institutions and corporates and support our team throughout the entire process - from prospecting and outreach to proposal writing and partnership management.
- You will have a lot of contact with colleagues from Justdiggit's other departments in order to provide the business development team with the latest information: updates on projects, photo and video material, presentations from other teams and so on. Other supporting activities are taking meeting notes, preparing meetings, preparing lunch with the other interns, managing the partnerships mailbox and more.
